Who is eligible to apply for the KAA Scholarship?

*Beginning Auctioneers *Apprentice and Principal KY Licensed Auctioneers

*Relatives of an active KAA member in good standing that have or will be graduating from an accredited high school or have completed the past year at an accredited college, university, or institution of higher education that intends on attending an Auction School or intends on working in the Auction Industry.

Applicants for scholarship must write a brief essay explaining why they are interested in or currently Pursuing a career in auctioneering and why they are applying for the scholarship. Scholarships will be awarded at the KAAAnnual Convention.
