CONTEST RULES

1. OPEN TO ALL RING PERSONS 18 AND OVER. Limited to 50 Contestants

2. Entry Fee: \$150 with Contestants providing 3 Items to sell at auction in the preliminary round. The aggregate item value and consequent combined sales total should be a minimum of \$200.00. Per KY State Law No Item can be Alcohol

3. DEADLINE FOR ENTRIES IS August 20, 2022 by 10:30am. This is a Jackpot type contest. The payout will depend on the number of entries in the contest. All the entry money for this contest will be paid back out as follows. 10 entries or less Winner takes all. 10-20 Contestants Winner gets 90%, Reserve gets 10%. 20-30 Contestants Winner gets 80%, Reserve gets 20%. 30-40 Contestants winner gets 70%, Reserve gets 30%. 40-50 Contestants Winner gets 60% Reserve gets 40%. Champion and Reserve will receive a Buckle

4. Ringman Contestants can choose the Auctioneer they want to sell for them as they compete.

5. Top 10 (Based on Preliminary Round points) Will compete in the Finals Round. Finalists will sell two items which will be provided by the Kentucky Auctioneers Association. Order for the Finals will be made by draw conducted by the Battle of the Bluegrass Committee. For 5 or less entries no finals, for 10 or less entries 3 finalist, 15 or less entries 5 finalist, 20 entries and above we will bring back the top 10.

7. All Contestants will compete in the open contest with no separate divisions. Contestants will be judged according to the Bluegrass Open Ringman Championship scorecard criteria. The decision of the judges is final. There will be 5 qualified Championship Judges for the Ringman Contest.

8. A mandatory meeting of all contestants will be held at 11:00 AM the day of contest.

9. All auction Items must be checked in by 10:30 AM contest day.

10. The scores will start new in the finals round. Preliminary round scores will be used only to determine the top 10 contestants who qualify for the final round (10 Finalist based on number of total entries into Ringman Contest) Preliminary Tie Breaker (1st) Best Score in the Ringman Category, (2nd) Best Score in the Overall Impression Category. FINALS Tie Breaker (1st) Highest Total preliminary round score, (2nd) 2nd Highest Score in the Preliminary round.

11. Contestant's performances will be videoed and live streamed. Contestants authorize, without compensation, use of any and all video, Internet, audio, photos, etc. as marketing material for promotional use by the Kentucky Auctioneers Association, Inc at this and any future event. Contestants will sell the 2 items they provide for this single run contest.

All Contestants will compete together with no separate divisions. Contestants will be judged according to the Battle of the Bluegrass Bid Calling Championship scorecard criteria. The decision of the judges is final. There will be 5 Championship/Industry Leading Judges.

The selling order of contestants will be established by random draw during the mandatory meeting at 8:30 am the day of contest. All Items must be checked in prior to the meeting by 8:30 am. We will be having a get together on Friday evening August 19, 2022 and would like to encourage you to check your items in on Friday if possible. Contestants that do not check in by 8:30 am Saturday will be ineligible.

Contestants will be judged on the following categories (1st) Best Score in Bid Calling Category, (2nd) Best Score Overall Impression Category. Tie breaker: If there is a tie, we will bring the contestants back to sell 1 item provided by the Kentucky Auctioneers Association the highest score in the categories above will be declared the winner.

2. Entry Fee: \$300 with Contestants providing three items to be sold in the Preliminary Round. The aggregate sales total for the three items should be a minimum of \$300.00. Per Kentucky State Law your item cannot be Alcohol. Also this year we will be having a get together on Friday, August 19 and would like all Contestants to attend and check in your items on Friday Night. This way we are not as rushed on Saturday Morning during Youth Open Contest.
3. DEADLINE FOR ENTRIES IS Monday August 8, 2022. No entries will be accepted after this date. Entries can be sent without payment but will not be valid unless payment is received on or before Monday August 8, 2022. The contest is limited to the first 50 paid entries for the Bid Calling Contest. A description of items to be sold is also due at that time. This is to have item descriptions and photos for print/online contest catalog. As well as Online bidding platform, the bidding will be live on the internet during the contest.
4. The Top 10 (Based on Preliminary Round point) will compete in a Finals Round. Finalist will sell two items, which will be provided by the Kentucky Auctioneers Association.
5. All Contestants will compete together with no separate divisions. Contestants will be judged according to the Bluegrass Open Bid Calling Championship scorecard criteria. The decision of the judges is final. There will be 5 Championship/Industry-Leading Judges for the Bid Calling contest.
6. The competition order for the preliminary rounds will be randomly generated by electronic means. The competition order for the Finals will be by draw conducted by the Battle of the Bluegrass Committee.
7. A mandatory meeting of all contestants will be at 11:00 AM Saturday prior to the contest. This time could vary depending how large our Youth Open Bid Calling Contest is.
8. The scores will start new in the Finals Round. Preliminary Round scores will be used only to determine the top 10 contestants who go to the Final's Round. Preliminary Tie Breaker (1st) Best Score in Bid Calling Category, (2nd) Best Score Overall Impression Category. FINALS Tie Breaker (1st) Highest Total Preliminary Score, (2nd) Highest Score in Bid Calling Category.
